Legislative

- Three Hills Victim Services dinner for First Responders is taking place on February 10 in Delbune, more information is required to see which fire departments are attending from our area.
- The Three Hills Health Center Charity Gala on December 2, 2017 “Christmas in Nashville,” requested sponsorship for the event, \$5000 was approved.

- Review of AAMDC proposed resolutions for Annual Convention next week. Resolutions include centralized assessments, uncollectible requisitions, OHV fees, Federal business tax, Wireworms and various legislative concerns.
- Central Alberta Economic Partnership (CAEP) representative presented its Annual Report to Council. Highlights included:
 - Province has double CAEP’s funding for 2018, and CAEP is requisitioning member municipalities 5 cents per capita increase for 2018.
 - CAEP is our strategic umbrella organization for municipal economic capacity in our region.
 - CAEP provides opportunities to meet/network with the regions business and community leaders, and runs the CARES (Community and Regional Economic Support) program through a foreign direct investment initiative.
