




Council Meeting Notes

June 26, 2018

<p>Finance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2018 Projects and Capital Report presented by Finance. Updates on gravel acquisition, Tangible Capital Assets (TCA) such as road projects, Non-TCA such as budget software, and capital equipment plans including vehicle replacements. Approved as info.
<p>Planning & Development</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Planning presents draft Land Use Bylaw Amendments, including Cannabis Legislation changes. Public consultation includes info on website, an open house, and an area to submit questions. More information, including the Draft LUB, will be available on website for public comments.
<p>Operations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Operations presents details on this year's Shoulder Pull Program, focused on the north-west portion of the County. 59 miles will be pulled to enhance longevity of our road system. With time and use, the surface material of the road gets spread out onto the roadside (shoulders) until the crown of the road is essentially squished out from the center to the sides. The Shoulder Pull maintenance brings the material back onto the main road surface and returns the road to its proper state, reducing road rebuilds and re-gravelling costs. The project is tentatively scheduled for the first week of August and should be completed within 30 days, weather permitting. Rge Rd 24-1 between Hwy 27 and Hwy 583 will have a magnesium calcium as a stabilizer applied as well, along with the project.  <p><i>Roads scheduled for the 2018 Shoulder Pull Program are highlighted in pink.</i></p>
