Delegations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Municipal Accountability Program by Alberta Municipal Affairs is a legislative review only, for all Alberta municipalities with a population under 5000. A report will be submitted to the CAO, and then distributed to Council and public.
Public Hearing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Council moves into the Public Hearing portion of the meeting in regards to the Land Use Bylaw #1773. Amendments have been summarized in the Sept. 25 agenda package (pg 10) including those that incorporate Cannabis Legislation.
Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Municipal Services Director presents an update on Planning, Ag & Parks, Protective Services, Water and Transportation Services. Horseshoe Canyon saw over 1600 visitors during the Long Table and Country Market in August!
Planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Council approves the third and final reading of Bylaw 1774, Redesignation from Ag District to Rec District for NE 32-31-25-W4M. The Development permit is the next step in the process following this redesignation.
Protective Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bylaw 1771, Public Consumption of Cannabis, second and third readings were passed with the following prohibition: a person must not smoke, vape or consume cannabis in any public place. Under the Access to Cannabis for Medical Purposes Regulation, this Bylaw does not apply.
Finance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Council approves the Bank Reconciliation from April to June 2018. The 2nd Quarterly Financial Report was presented, including actuals as of June 30, 2018. Operating (pg 178) and Project Report (pg 193) are included in the Sept 25 Council package, available on our website.
Legislative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information presented as requested for the potential Ghost Pine/Orkney Water System. The estimated cost of a reservoir is \$2 million. Dedicated fill line will cost between \$600,000 and \$2.2 million. Distribution estimated cost for approx. 75 km of pipeline is \$7.5 million. Accepted as information. Per Capita Levy Rates for Marigold Library System for 2018 totals \$51,310 and in 2019 totaling \$52,510. Council approves the 5-year levy schedule, with increases, as presented. Wednesday, October 17, 2018 is Trochu's Flapjack Fiesta from 5-7 pm. Council approves attendance of Councillor Christie (Deputy Reeve King is away). The County also has contributed \$200 towards the event, through Policy 15-7, Recreation and Community Events. Council Committee Reports were reviewed and approved including Drumheller RCMP statistics, Kneehill Regional FCSS, Committee of the Whole Minutes, and County Parks Committee Minutes Council directed administration to proceed with a land lease with Artis Exploration Ltd. Council passed second and third readings for Bylaw 1773, Land Use Bylaw.
