The scene of the incident involving a train and a B-Train propane truck in Swalwell has been cleared.

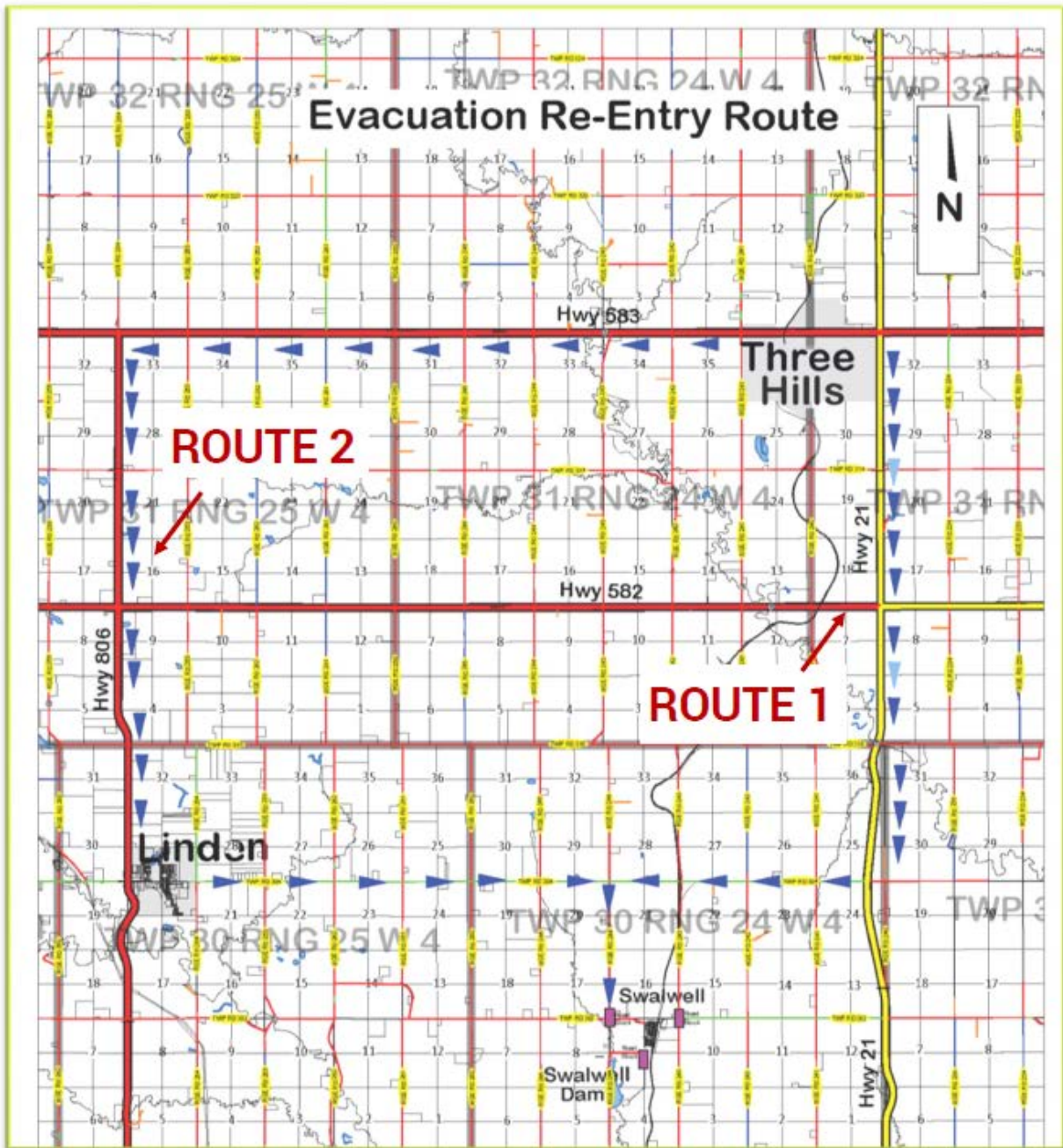
